1. Filix shines in CBSE Results – School average way above than State and National Average

On 2nd November, CBSE released the School Performance Report Card, and Filix School proudly recorded an outstanding achievement. Our school average stands significantly higher than both the state and national averages, reaffirming our commitment to academic excellence. Notably, Filix holds the highest school average among boys in West Bengal, further strengthening our reputation for quality education.

2. Swachhta Activity

On 4th November, students of Grades 1 and 2 participated in a Swachhta Activity, cleaning the nearby park area. The young learners enthusiastically contributed to maintaining cleanliness and gained early lessons in responsibility, hygiene, and community involvement.

3. Nurturing Medicinal Plants Activity

On 6th November, the students of Grade 2 engaged in an enriching activity under the theme Nurturing Medicinal Plants. They observed and explored plants like Tulsi and Mint, learning about their medicinal importance and developing a deeper appreciation for nature.

On 8th November, the Samya Karpha Recitation Club was inaugurated to enhance creativity, expression, and speaking skills among children. The initiative aims to build confidence and provide a joyful platform for performance and articulation.

5. Samar Bagchi Maths Olympiad

Filix School collaborated with Purulia District Police and Cheenta Academy, Kolkata, for the Samar Bagchi Maths Olympiad, where around 5000 students from government schools across Purulia participated. This initiative reflects our commitment to strengthening

academic outreach in the community. The top 200 students were felicitated at a ceremony organised by District Police at Purulia. Further, shortlisted children would undergo Olympiad and higher Mathematics training.

6. CBSE Workshop on Critical & Creative Thinking

On 8th and 9th November, a two-day CBSE Capacity Building Workshop on Critical and Creative Thinking was organised for teachers, enriching classroom methodologies and equipping educators with innovative tools to foster higher-order thinking skills.

7. Children's Day Celebration

Children's Day was celebrated on 14th November with great enthusiasm. Teachers conducted a special assembly, and sweets and snacks were distributed. Friendly games, including a cricket match and "Passing the Ball," were played between teachers and students, creating memorable moments of joy.

8. Filix Annual Creative Arts Workshop

From 16th to 22nd November, the Filix Annual Creative Arts Workshop was conducted, offering intensive training in art, fashion, mime, music, rhythm, folk dance, Bharatnatyam and Odissi. Students explored various art forms under expert guidance, enriching their creative abilities.

Filix Fest was held on 23rd November, where students showcased exceptional talent in Art, Music, Rhythm, Bharatnatyam, Folk, Odissi and Mime. The school was honoured to have the guidance and mentorship of Smt. Sharmila Biswas, the legendary Odissi dancer and choreographer. The event was witnessed by more than 600 people, earning appreciation from parents and guests.

10. CBSE SAFAL Assessment

The CBSE SAFAL assessment for Grades 6 and 9 concluded successfully, marking another step toward competency-based evaluation aligned with NEP 2020.

11. Visit of Nelson from SDSU

Nelson from San Diego State University visited the school and conducted hands-on microbiology activities with students, enhancing their scientific curiosity through real-time experiments.

12. Initiation of DFC Activities

Design for Change (DFC) activities were initiated for Grades V to IX and XI, encouraging students to identify real-life problems and implement meaningful solutions to bring positive change.

14. Queen’s Commonwealth Essay Competition 2025

In the Queen’s Commonwealth Essay Competition 2025, thirteen students participated, and the school secured 1 Gold, 1 Silver, and 3 Bronze Awards, showcasing strong literary talent.

15. English Speech Recital Achievement

16. State-Level VVM Selection
