**Discover the World of Economics – Cohort II**

The second cohort of *Discover the World of Economics* was successfully conducted in the first week of January. The programme featured eminent resource persons including Prof. Mahan Maharaj (TIFR), Dr. Kaushik Basu, Prof. Prabhat Pattnayak (JNU), Prof. Anand (Azim Premji University), Prof. Abhinandan Sinha (Ahmedabad University), Somya Bajaj (World Bank) and Prof. Mausami Das. The sessions provided deep conceptual insights and encouraged students to engage critically with economic ideas and contemporary issues.

Around 80 students from across the country participated in the Economics camp, representing reputed institutions such as La Martiniere (Kolkata), Navkis Educational Centre (Bengaluru and Mysuru), The Heritage School (Kolkata), Podar International School, Billabong International School (Pune), Klorophyll (Berhampur, Odisha), Ladakh Government School, and Ramakrishna Mission Schools. The diverse participation enriched discussions and fostered collaborative learning at a national level.

**Achievement in All India Swachh Bharat Competition**

Students of Filix School won medals and certificates in the All India Swachh Bharat Competition. Their achievements reflect strong awareness of cleanliness, civic responsibility and social commitment, aligning with national values and community engagement.

**Makar Sankranti Kite-Making Activity**

On the occasion of Makar Sankranti, Kindergarten students enthusiastically participated in a kite-making activity. The colourful session helped develop fine motor skills and creativity while introducing children to the cultural significance of the festival in a joyful learning environment.

**Annual Sports Day Celebration**

The Annual Sports Day was celebrated with great enthusiasm, with events for Junior students held on 13th January and for Senior students on 15th January. Students actively participated in various track and field events, showcasing sportsmanship, teamwork and physical fitness.

### **Inter-House Debate Competition**

A debate competition was organised for Middle and Senior School students to promote critical thinking and articulation skills. Middle School students debated on the topic "*Freedom comes only with discipline*", while Senior School students discussed "*History is the study of the present.*" The competition witnessed thoughtful arguments and confident participation. This event was graced by the presence of Ms. Hilda Peacock, Chairperson, Filix School of Education.

### **Saraswati Puja Celebration**

Saraswati Puja was celebrated on 23rd January with devotion and reverence. The programme included a traditional puja at the temple, bhajans rendered by the school choir, and distribution of prasad to all members of the school community, fostering spiritual values and cultural awareness.
